

Learn to knit - Lace Rib Panel



This written tutorial can be used with the video tutorial on the "Handmade by Stacy J" YouTube channel. It's a beginner friendly pattern that works over 7 stitches on a background of Reverse Stockinette over 4 rows.

Difficulty level: Easy

Stitches used: Knit (k), Purl (p), Yarn Over (yo)

Special Stitches used:

Skpo: Slip, knit, pass over (slip one stitch purl wise, knit the next st, pass slipped stitch over - one stitch decreased)

Sk2po: Slip, k2tog, pass over (slip one st purlwise, knit next 2 stitches together, pass slipped stitch over - 2 stitches decreased)

Materials Needed:

Paintbox Yarns - Simply DK (100% Acrylic; 100g / 3.5oz; Light #3 weight); Color #131 Seafoam Blue

KnitPicks Straight Knitting needles, size 6 (4.00 mm)

For sample, I cast on 17 for a border of rev st st of 5 sts on each side - the directions below only reflect the lace portion of the pattern.

Row 1 (RS): P1, yo, skpo, k1, k2tog, yo, p1

Row 2 (WS): K1, p5, k1

Row 3: P1, k1, yo, sk2po, yo, k1, p1

Row 4: K1, p5, k1

Rep rows 1-4 until desired length is reached, binding off on row 4 as pattern.

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
